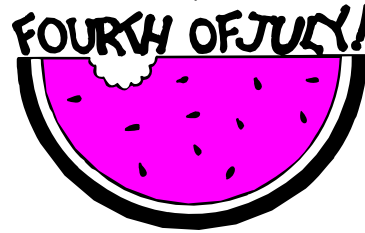


MATTHEW'S GOSPEL: The Monday-evening Bible Study will continue discussing the Gospel of

participated in the Photo Directory. Come to any of the following Masses to pick up your copy:

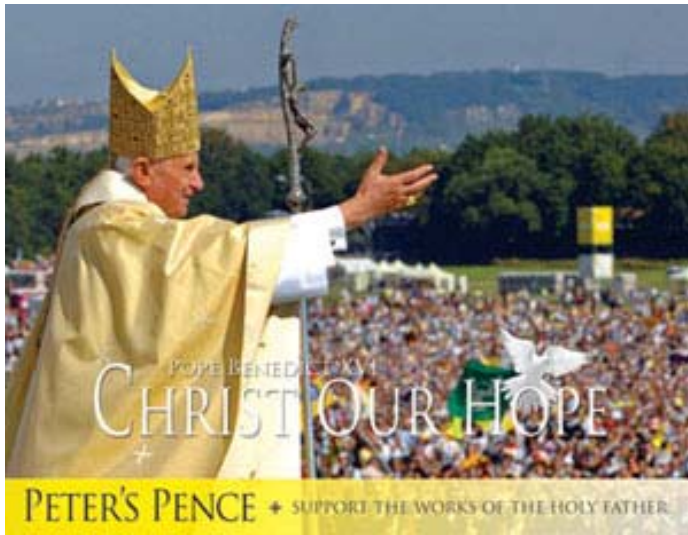
