The Divine Love Prayer

Thy Kingdom come.

Eucharistic Heart of Jesus
Make us one in mind, heart and will, with You, the Father and the Holy Spirit.

Eucharistic Heart of Jesus
Gentle and humble of heart, make my heart like unto Thine.

Eucharistic Heart of Jesus
Through the infinite value of each holy Sacrifice of the Mass, offered now and until the end of time, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Eucharistic Heart of Jesus
Thank You for the personal love You have for me in the Blessed Sacrament.

Eucharistic Heart of Jesus
with all my heart, I love You.

Eucharistic Heart of Jesus
I put all my trust in you.

This prayer may be said on the beads of a rosary. A 'Glory Be' replaces the 'Our Father' while the 'Hail Mary' is replaced by these prayers to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. After the 'Glory Be', each prayer is repeated ten times on the beads until all nine 'decades' are completed.
