The Gabriel Project at St. Catherine Laboure Church, which began 9 years ago, is an interparish outreach combining volunteers from over 12 parishes. Volunteers are currently being sought. Some of the ways one can help are:

Volunteer to **drive** pregnant mothers to doctor's appointments.

Volunteer to **drive** a mother to Manna Food in Rockville once a month.

Serve as an **Angel Friend**, someone who will befriend a pregnant mother by a friendly phone call once a week, by delivering clothing, diapers etc. provided by the Gabriel Project, and by offering spiritual support. This average time commitment is 2 hours per month.

Volunteer to **cook** a meal for new mothers once the baby has arrived.

Volunteer to **pray** for all the families being helped by the project.
