Drop off your donations and stay for coffee and conversation.

We depend on both your donations and your volunteer help to continue this Holy Cross tradition.

Donations: It costs approximately 65 cents an item to cover all needed supplies. We count on the generosity of your donations each Sunday to continue this event. However, please don't hesitate to stop in if you've forgotten your cash any week. We still welcome you and no one checks what you donate. Perhaps you'll consider a slightly larger donation the next time you are able to.

Volunteer help: If you can spare an hour or two a month we welcome your involvement in making this a successful weekly event. All ages are welcome. Helping is a great ice breaker for meeting people in the parish. If you are an early morning person, we start setting up between 6:45 and 7:00 am. If you like to sleep in on a Sunday, you can still make coffee and donuts part of your Sunday ritual, cleanup generally starts about 10:00 am.
