The Bible Timeline - Journey through the Bible is an 24-part video learning system. This study designed and hosted by Jeff Cavins (seen on EWTN) gives us a compelling in-depth view of God's plan of salvation, from Genesis through the resurrection of Christ and the establishment of the Catholic Church. We learn how to enter deeper into "His-story" as we read and study the Scriptures. You will find that Jeff Cavins is an engaging and enthusiastic speaker.

At Holy Cross we covered Genesis, Exodus and Numbers during the Fall, and will cover the remaining 11 narrative books during Winter and Spring sessions. Our starting point will be the book of Joshua and the story of Israel crossing the Jordan River and entering the Promised Land.

You will learn: The major people, places, events, and themes of the Bible as seen in the 14 narrative books of the Bible.

How the 14 narrative books fit in with the other 59 books of the Bible.

A practical plan for reading through the Bible in one year.
